1. What Event Led to A Heartfelt Reunion Between Prince Harry and King Charles in February 2024?

• Harry returned to the UK after King Charles was diagnosed with cancer.

4. Who Is the First Western Journalist to Interview Vladimir Putin Since the Invasion of Ukraine Began?

• Tucker Carlson, offering a controversial platform for Putin's perspectives.

In a move that surprised many and confirmed some suspicions, Tucker Carlson, the former Fox News host known for his divisive commentary, <u>secured a landmark interview with Russian President Vladimir Putin</u>. This interview, conducted in Moscow, marks the first engagement of its kind since Russia's full-scale invasion of Ukraine two years prior. <u>Carlson's trip and subsequent interview</u> have been framed

as an effort to bring an alternative perspective to the American public, contrasting with what he describes as biased coverage of the Western media. <u>The decision by the Kremlin</u> to grant Carlson, a figure criticized for promoting conspiracy theories and extremist views, this exclusive opportunity has sparked discussions about the motivations behind it.
