1. How old is the oldest known gorilla in the world?

Fatou, <u>a western lowland gorilla believed to be the oldest globally</u>, celebrated her <u>65th birthday on Apr. 13, 2022, at the Berlin Zoo</u>. In 2019, <u>Fatou was named the "oldest living gorilla in captivity" by Guinness</u> <u>World Records</u> after Trudy, a gorilla born in 1956, died. Gorillas usually live up to 50 years in captivity.



2. What kind of spider is this?

Jorō spiders, or Trichonephila clavata, are <u>Japanese spiders with colorful</u> <u>yellow, blue and red markings that measure three inches (8 cm) in length</u>. Jorō spiders are venomous but pose little to no threat to humans.

Joro in the USA

The Joro spiders took over north Georgia in 2021 and were spotted in South Carolina. According to a study of the Jorō spider species published in <u>Feb. 2022 in the journal</u> <u>Physiological Entomology</u>, they could also spread into the northeastern United States.



3. What's the world's largest plant?

Poseidon's ribbon weed, or <u>Posidonia australis</u>, found in Shark Bay, off the western end of Australia, is <u>the world's largest plant</u>. The seagrass — <u>not to be confused with seaweed and algae</u> — <u>spreads at least 180 km (77 square miles</u>), about the size of Cincinnati. A new study <u>published on June 1, 2022</u>, in Proceedings of the Royal Society shows that Shark Bay's Poseidon's ribbon weed colony is <u>one giant organism that has been cloning for about 4,500 years</u>, the largest known example of a clone in any environment on <u>Earth</u>.

World Record

Is it the largest organism on Earth?

Utah's Pando, <u>a clonal colony of 40,000 aspen trees connected by their</u> <u>roots</u>, is the former "<u>heaviest known organism</u>." covering an area of about 500 square meters (0.16 square miles) and weighing 6,000 tons. But <u>the</u> <u>Humongous Fungus</u> is probably even more enormous, weaving a web of mycelial tendrils (the root network of mushrooms) covering 3.7 square miles (9.6 square km) of Oregon's Malheur National Forest. <u>Scientists</u> <u>calculate it could weigh at least 7,500 tons and maybe up to 35,000 tons</u>, making it <u>the world's most massive living organism</u>.



4. The city of Memphis, Tennessee, is named after which country's Memphis?

Memphis, Egypt, was <u>the ancient capital of the Lower Egypt district of mhw</u> <u>("north")</u>. Its ruins - 20 km (12 mi) south of Giza (just outside Cairo) - include <u>the Saqqara site</u>, which contains ancient burial grounds of Egyptian royalty, serving as <u>the necropolis for ancient Memphis</u>.

How many new mummies were found in 2022?

On May 30, 2022, Egypt displayed <u>250 painted sarcophagi with well-preserved mummies inside and 150 bronze statues of ancient deities and bronze vessels used in rituals of Isis</u>, the goddess of fertility, all dating back 2,500 years. Egypt's Supreme Council of Antiquities displayed the artifacts at the feet of the <u>Step Pyramid of Djoser in Saqqara</u>. The relics will be transferred for a permanent exhibit at the new <u>Grand Egyptian Museum</u>, still under construction near the famed Giza Pyramids. <u>Take a look</u>.

5. Where is Sharm el-Sheikh?

2022's UN climate conference will be <u>hosted at the Egyptian coastal resort</u> of Sharm el-Sheikh from Nov. 6-18. A <u>sponsorship agreement between the</u> <u>conference and Coca-Cola</u>, which has been described as <u>the "world's top</u> <u>plastic polluter,"</u> has angered environmentalists.

6. Which company is the world's biggest plastic polluter?

The <u>Coca-Cola Company is ranked as the world's top plastic polluter for the</u> <u>4th consecutive year, according to the 2021 Break Free From Plastic report</u>. Since 2019, Brand Audit found Coca-Cola branded products stand for more pollution than the next two top polluters, PepsiCo and Unilever, combined.

<u>Claims about plastic packaging being eco-friendly made by big brands,</u> <u>including Coca-Cola and Unilever, are misleading greenwashing</u>, according to a report by the Changing Markets Foundation. Case in point: <u>The world's</u> <u>largest plastic polluter</u>, <u>Coca-Cola</u>, <u>has spent millions promoting the notion</u> <u>that its bottles are 25% marine plastic</u>.

7. As of Oct. 2022, what's the size of the Antarctic ozone hole?

According to NASA, <u>the ozone hole topped 10 million square miles (26.4 million square kilometers, more than the size of North America) on Oct. 5, 2022</u>, the largest it has been since 2015. It's the third year in which the ozone hole peaked at over 9.5 million square miles. Despite <u>recent data, the hole is still shrinking</u>.

8. The monkeypox outbreaks in Europe and North America are concentrated among who?

In Africa, <u>monkeypox mainly spread to people by infected wild animals</u> in limited outbreaks. In Europe and America, <u>99% of all monkeypox cases</u> were in men. Of those, <u>98% involved men who have sex with men</u>.

Health

How many people have been affected so far?

According to the US Centers for Disease Control, <u>more than 16,500 cases of</u> <u>monkeypox have been reported in 74 countries since May 2022</u>.

In comparison to smallpox, Western African monkeypox is what?

Monkeypox is a virus that can cause fever, aches, and a distinctive bumpy rash. It is <u>related to smallpox but is usually milder, particularly the West</u> <u>African strain of the virus</u>, which has a fatality rate of around 1%. <u>Most</u> <u>people fully recover in two to four weeks. The first human case of</u> <u>monkeypox was recorded in 1970 in the Democratic Republic of</u> <u>Congo</u> during the intensified effort to end smallpox.

Did WHO declare a monkeypox global emergency?

The World Health Organization chief said on July 23, 2022, that <u>the</u> <u>monkeypox outbreak in over 70 countries is an "extraordinary" situation</u> <u>that qualifies as a global emergency</u>. He called for the world to <u>"act together</u> <u>in solidarity" regarding the distribution of treatments, tests, and vaccines</u> <u>for monkeypox</u>.



9. What's in the picture?

Nasa <u>released a new view of the "Pillars of Creation" from the James Webb</u> <u>Space Telescope on Oct. 19, 2022</u>. The image of <u>the pillars with</u> <u>semitransparent gas and dust indicates that young stars are forming</u> - or have barely broken out of their dusty cocoons.



10. What is the ice-encrusted moon of Jupiter named?

Juno, <u>NASA's spacecraft orbiting Jupiter since 2016</u>, flew <u>within 219 miles</u> (352 kilometers) of Jupiter's moon Europa's surface on Sept. 29, 2022, at a speed of more than 30,000 mph. The <u>spacecraft made the closest</u> observation of Jupiter's ice-covered moon since Jan. 2000.

What am I seeing?

The <u>image shows long fractures running across the bright, icy surface</u> -Fractures that indicate that <u>an ocean lies beneath the ice of Europa, causing</u> the rupture through stress due to rising and falling tides.



11. What happened within 12 hours of Elon Musk's purchase of Twitter?

Elon Musk's <u>purchase of Twitter on Oct. 28, 2022</u>, led to <u>a 500% increase in</u> <u>the use of the N-word to demean Black people on the platform within just</u> <u>12 hours</u>, according to <u>the National Contagion Research Institute</u>, a disinformation tracking agency. Users were <u>encouraged to amplify</u> <u>derogatory slurs on Twitter in several posts on the 4chan</u> fringe message board website.



Is Trump returning to Twitter?

As of Nov. 2, 2022, Elon Musk announced that <u>Twitter would only allow</u> people banned from its site to return once it sets up procedures on how to <u>do so</u>. That includes the former President, <u>despite a fake meme stating</u> <u>otherwise</u>.

12. What's Google's messaging app?



In recent years, <u>Google has</u> released several messaging apps that failed to significantly impact the market, including Google Talk, <u>Google + Messenger, Google Voice,</u> Allo, Duo, and the long-forgotten <u>Google Wave</u>. Starting on Nov. 1, 2022, <u>Hangouts has joined the list</u> and automatically redirects to <u>Google Chat on the web</u>. As outlined in the company's announcement, all messages and contacts will automatically be migrated to the new system.

13. What was the Russian cruiser Moskva?

The Russian Navy's <u>Moskva was a guided-missile cruiser</u>. She led <u>the</u> <u>Russian naval invasion of Ukraine in 2022</u> and sank 100 km off the coast of Odesa on Apr. 14, 2022. According to Ukrainian officials and the US Department of Defense, <u>Ukraine fired two anti-ship missiles at the cruiser</u>. The Russian Ministry of Defense claimed a fire triggered a munitions explosion that sank the ship.



<u>A Ukrainian fighter holding up his middle finger in front of the</u>

<u>vessel</u> appears on one million stamps released by Ukraine's national postal service shortly before the Moskva was sunk.

What's the Dollar value of 30,000 Roubles?



As of mid-March 2022, \$1 is worth 99 Russian Roubles, making 30,000 Roubles worth exactly \$280 (about £215). That's the fine a Russian court punished Marina Ovsyannikova with for violating local protest laws. Ovsyannikova broke onto a live Mar. 14, 2022, news broadcast on Russia's state TV Channel One in a demonstration against Russia's invasion of Ukraine. The court fined her a

day later for a video statement she made before the protest in which she said she was <u>"ashamed" of having worked at Channel One and spreading "Kremlin</u> propaganda" - not for breaking onto the Channel One set.



14. Where did Queen Elizabeth II appoint Liz Truss as Prime Minister in her final days?

For the first time in her 70-year reign as queen, <u>Elizabeth II appointed a</u> <u>new prime minister away from Buckingham Palace</u>. Liz Truss <u>became the</u> <u>UK's Prime Minister in Balmoral Castle, Scotland</u>, on Sept. 6, 2022, where the queen, who suffered from mobility issues during her final days, <u>was</u> <u>taking her summer break</u>.

The Queen's Death

Queen Elizabeth II <u>died peacefully at Balmoral on Sept. 8, 2022</u>. The Prince of Wales, who was at his mother's side, became King Charles at once. <u>The flag at Buckingham Palace was lowered to half-mast at 6.30 pm</u>.

15. Where is Queen Elizabeth's final resting place



The queen's coffin's final destination is Windsor Castle, <u>in</u> the King George VI <u>Memorial Chapel</u>. Prince Philip's coffin joined the <u>queen's in the</u> <u>memorial chapel</u>. St. George's Chapel <u>has long</u> Oueen

been the final resting place for British royals, and <u>10 former monarchs</u>, including the queen's mother and father, are buried there.



16. When did lynching become a federal crime in the US?

On Mar. 29, 2022, President Biden signed a bill <u>making lynching a federal</u> <u>crime for the first time in the United States</u>. The law is named for Emmett Till, <u>the Black boy murdered in Mississippi in 1955</u>. The anti-lynching movement first introduced legislation to criminalize lynching <u>in 1935</u>, but it was <u>repeatedly blocked more than 200 times</u>. The bill, which makes <u>lynching punishable by up to 30 years in prison</u>, finally passed the House in Feb. 2022 with only three lawmakers opposing it and passed the Senate without objection on Mar. 28.

17. Ketanji Brown Jackson is the first what?

Ketanji Brown Jackson is the first Black female justice in the Supreme Court's 200-plus-year history. She is the second Supreme Court justice since 1870 to be confirmed without a single vote from the Senate minority party. The first is Amy Coney Barrett.

But what are Ketanji Brown Jackson's credentials?

In late February 2022, FOX News scandalist Tucker Carlson demanded that Jackson reveal her LSAT scores - implying she hasn't had the credentials to be a Supreme Court Justice. Actually, Jackson attended Harvard Law School, where she was a supervising editor of the Harvard Law Review. She graduated in 1996 with a Juris Doctor cum laude, spent 15 years as a public defender, and served eight years as a trial court judge in the US district court in DC. On the other hand, Amy Coney Barrett holds the records as the first Supreme Court justice without an Ivy League degree since the 2010 retirement of John Paul Stevens and the only Supreme Justice who did not receive her Juris Doctor from Harvard or Yale.



18. How many firearms are there per 100 people in the US?

Figures from the <u>Small Arms Survey</u> - a Swiss-based leading research project - estimate <u>390 million guns in circulation in the US in 2018</u>. That's <u>a</u> <u>ratio of 120.5 guns per 100 people</u>, making <u>the US the only nation on Earth</u> <u>with more civilian firearms than people</u>. In comparison, Canada has a ratio of 34.7 guns per 100 people, 12.9 guns per 100 people in Mexico, and The UK has a rate of 5.03 firearms per 100 people.

What happened at Robb Elementary School in Uvalde, Texas?

An <u>18-year-old shooter killed at least 19 children and two adults on May</u> <u>24, 2022, at Robb Elementary School in Uvalde, Texas</u> - the deadliest American school shooting since <u>the massacre at Sandy Hook Elementary in</u> <u>Newtown, Connecticut</u>, a decade ago.

How do mass shooters buy guns in the US?

From 1966 to 2019, <u>77 percent of mass shooters obtained the weapons</u> <u>they used through legal purchases</u>, according to data compiled by <u>the</u> <u>National Institute of Justice</u>, the research wing of the Justice Department.

19. Which country elected Lula as its leader in 2022?

On Oct. 30, 2022, Brazilian leftist leader Luiz Inacio <u>"Lula" da Silva won a</u> <u>third non-consecutive presidential term</u>. The 77-year-old former metalworker <u>spent 19 months in jail for corruption convictions before the</u> <u>Supreme Federal Court annulled them in June 2021</u>. He has <u>vowed to</u> <u>overturn former President Bolsonaro's far-right policies, including pro-gun</u> <u>measures and weak protection of the Amazon rainforest</u>.

20. Rishi Sunak is the UK's first prime minister to be what?

After Liz Truss's record short tenure as the UK's Prime Minister in 2022, Rishi Sunak became <u>the kingdom's first non-white prime minister</u> (and <u>its</u> <u>first Hindu prime minister</u>) on Oct. 25, 2022. Sunak is <u>probably also the</u> <u>first non-alcoholic prime minister in the UK since David Lloyd George</u>. Benjamin Disraeli, a Tory MP of Jewish heritage, was <u>the first minority</u> <u>ethnic British prime minister</u>.

21. What's Uber's "Kill Switch"?

Senior executives at Uber ordered the use of a "kill switch" <u>to prevent</u> police and regulators from accessing sensitive data during raids on its offices in at least six countries: France, the Netherlands, Belgium, India, <u>Hungary, and Romania</u>. The Guardian found the information on Uber files, a <u>cache of leaked confidential company data</u> published on July 11, 2022.

22. Which company "deleted" Kanye West after his 2022 antisemitic remarks?

After tweeting that he was going "death con 3 ON JEWISH PEOPLE," Ye's Instagram and Twitter accounts were blocked, and <u>JP Morgan and</u> <u>Balenciaga ceased collaborating with him</u>. Adidas announced on Oct. 26, 2022, that <u>it would stop manufacturing Yeezy products and stop paying</u> <u>West and his companies immediately</u>. <u>Madame Tussaud's London ceased</u> <u>showing the star's wax figure on</u> Oct. 27. Forbes estimated that <u>West's net</u> <u>worth is around \$400m (£346m) - down from \$2bn (£1.7bn)</u>.

Damien Hirst is the United Kingdom's richest living artist, with a net worth of \$700 million in 2021.

What is Damien Hirst's The Currency? The Currency is the first NFT collection by Damien Hirst of 10,000 NFTs, corresponding to 10,000 unique physical artworks stored in a secure vault in the UK. Hirst produced the project with HENI, an art services business. HENI sold each image in the series for the price of \$2,000.

They grossed about \$18 million from the initial sale and, according to HENI, are collecting a further 5 percent of the proceeds from NFT resales.

26. Why did Damien Hirst burn artworks collectively worth almost £10 million?

Buyers of <u>The Currency were allowed to choose the physical artwork or the</u> <u>NFT representing it</u>. If they chose the NFT, Hirst promised to destroy their physical pieces. Hirst burned the pieces between Oct. 12-30 at London's Newport Street Gallery.

In a deal with BTS' management company HYBE announced on Jul. 11, 2022, <u>Disney will stream a BTS documentary series and concert on its</u> <u>streaming services next year</u>. In <u>"BTS Monuments: Beyond the Star," the</u> <u>group's members will reveal their daily lives, thoughts, and plans</u>, including music and footage from the past nine years.

What else does the BTS-Disney deal include?

The agreement also includes a recording of the group's first performance in November 2021, following a 2-year interval caused by the COVID-19 pandemic. Furthermore, this deal features the reality show "In the Soop: <u>Friendcation</u>," which features V from BTS, Seo-jun Park from "Itaewon Class," Woo-Shik Choi from "Parasite," singer and actor Hyung-Sik Park, and rapper Peakboy taking a surprise trip. In June 2022, <u>BTS announced it</u> <u>was taking a break while members worked on solo projects</u>.

After what does BTS plan to come back together as a group "around 2025"?

When <u>all seven of BTS's members complete their mandatory military</u> <u>service</u>, <u>"around 2025,"</u> their label and management company <u>Big Hit</u>, <u>plans</u> <u>to reunite them as a group</u>. BTS's oldest performer, Jin, plans to enlist as soon as his late-Oct. 2022 solo project releases. Jin <u>will be the first BTS</u> <u>member to enlist</u>.
