Elon Musk <u>endorsed Donald Trump for the 2024 presidential election shortly after the shooting incident at a Trump rally</u> in Butler, Pennsylvania, on July 13, 2024. Musk <u>announced his endorsement approximately 30 minutes after the incident</u> via his social media platform, X, expressing <u>his support for Trump's campaign and wishing him a rapid recovery</u>.

Two former US presidents survived assassination attempts: Theodore Roosevelt and Donald Trump. Roosevelt was shot in 1912 while campaigning for the presidency as a third-party candidate but survived and continued his speech. Donald Trump was also the target of an assassination attempt on July 13, 2024, during a rally in Butler, Pennsylvania. He was shot in the upper part of his right ear but was not severely injured.

A one-time Trump critic, his position as a 2020 election denier ultimately led to his selection as Donald Trump's vice presidential running mate on July 15, 2024.

Elon Musk's social media platform X, formerly known as Twitter, faced <u>EU regulatory issues after changing its verification system to allow users to purchase blue checkmarks</u>. This new model, introduced after <u>Musk acquired the platform in October 2022</u>, misled users about account authenticity as it <u>shifted from verifying notable figures to paid subscriptions</u>. On July 12, 2024, the European Commission's investigation <u>found this practice deceptive and violating the Digital Services Act</u>, which regulates online content and transparency. <u>X now faces potential fines and operational changes to comply with EU regulations</u>.

5. What Does It Mean When a Trial in The US Is Dismissed with Prejudice?

- The defendant is found guilty but not punished.
- The case is permanently closed and cannot be filed again.
- The case can be retried with new evidence.

When a trial in the US is <u>dismissed with prejudice</u>, the case is <u>permanently closed and cannot be refiled or retried in the future</u>. This ruling was the outcome of <u>Alec Baldwin's involuntary manslaughter trial</u> related to the "Rust" shooting incident. On July 12, 2024, <u>Judge Mary Marlowe Sommer dismissed the charges against Baldwin with prejudice</u>, preventing any future legal actions for the same charges. The decision came after the defense successfully argued <u>Baldwin's reliance on film professionals for gun safety and highlighted procedural errors</u>.

6. Which Team Has Won the Most UEFA European Championship Titles in History?
